We are all fine. We were doing a radio show with Rene Saez, in Arica, Chile when the lights went out, and the building began to gyrate.

The telephone lines outside began to swing wildly, and we sat in the building for about 5 minutes as the situation increased. The radio station in Santiago, Chile called to see how things were in Arica. The center of the quake was below Calama. Three houses collapsed, but mostly the city is ok.

The local soundings said the Arica effect of the quake was 7.7, the Calama, Chile sector was 8 on the Richter scale. This morning, while getting ready for another radio broadcast, we had another

4 on the Richter Scale. So, we think the Lord is in on this trip.

We are now in Calama. At this point, we plan to have a meeting Thursday, 8pm, Friday at 11 am and 8:30 pm, Saturday with Susan for Ladies at 4, and Trevor at 8pm Sunday, at 11, 4 and 6:00 pm, and our bus returns to Arica at 10:30pm on Sunday, arriving at 7am Monday. Tuesday the 21st, we board the Plane in Tacna, Peru for the return to Lima, Miami, Denver and Seattle.

Thanks for your prayers. We have had tremendous meetings. 5 churches in Santiago, Chile want us to come in October of 2008; then on to 5 Churches in the Arica, Chile area, then to Mexico in November. The time is short, and the number of churches and ministers is increasing.
