We estimate that in all total there were from 90 to 100 people healed as we prayed in every meeting for the sick , hurting and for other things. Simon, the Australian contact who is originally from Peru, has spoken to Victor. Plans are now in play for Victor to visit Lima, and the villages where 20+ churches in one area and another 27+ are in another area of Peru. We pray the networking of FCMI will be seen again as the Lord puts the net together for the fulfillment again of His statement that "I will make you fishers of Men".
