BACK TO BASICS

The present need I see in the churches we visit is the need to press once again, as Jude, the half brother of Jesus said,

3 Beloved, while I was very diligent to write to you concerning our common salvation, I found it necessary to write to you exhorting you to contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints. NKJV

The first principles of the faith are outlined in [Hebrews 6:1-2](#) that being repentant from dead works, faith toward God, the doctrine of baptisms (washings, water, Holy Spirit fire), laying on of hands, resurrection of the dead and eternal judgment. These are prerequisites for us to **"GO ON TO PERFECTION"**! That is just growing up in Christ.

We have seen this need in many churches when the question is asked: How many of you have been baptized in water? How many are baptized in the Holy Spirit with ability to pray in the Spirit so you can build yourself up in your most Holy Faith, as is stated by [Jude](#) in verse [20](#)? Praying in the Spirit is the offset against the things of the world that inundated the life of the saints so long ago, the same as it does today.

How many times have we, the ministers of the Lord, inquired as to the spiritual climate in the homes, on the job and in the quite secret place, of the saints entrusted to our care? Are they/we living a life of repentance – daily turning away from the actions on TV, on the radio, in the home, of that which grieves the heart of the Lord?

We are living in a society, whether in the USA, Australia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Mexico, Canada...etc, where the philosophies need to be overwhelmed by the Life and Spirit of Christ! Overcome hate with love said Jesus. Overwhelm "Fear" with adventurous boldness. Overcome "Out of Control" with the spirit of Self Control.

We need to encourage the saints today in the simple things. Praying in the Spirit! Building yourself up in your most Holy Faith! God's faith! God's word! God's purpose for our life!

TRAVEL

Travel: We have been visiting the churches in the states most of this year. We have sensed an unusual urgency to take more time with the American churches. For the last 3 years, there have been more prophetic words for us to focus on the saints here for their calling and ministry in the Churches. There has been a good growth of teaching and evangelistic ministries among

the fellowship which is very much needed.

The Pastors are often overwhelmed and need to know there are five ministries the Lord has put in the church to cause them to be equipped to the work of the ministry. We are presently asking and praying for the saints to make their calling and election sure by fulfilling the ministry Christ has given them!

August:

It is summer here. We are seeing the ministries and churches in Washington, Nevada and Idaho now. My mother is nearing 90; she is feeble of late. So, the plan is to gather the great grandchildren around her before she passes away and take pictures for them to remember for their children.

1-21 Will be spent in the northwest.

22-24 FCMI-200 Conference.

This focus is the churches/ministries that are up to 200 numerically. All may come and enjoy the friendship building, but the focus of this time is to let the ministers/saints know that 95% of all the churches around the world are on average, 57 persons per church. To have such a

normal church is a great thing in the furtherance of the Kingdom of Christ. One does not need to have thousands to be counted faithful and successful in the eyes of the Lord. Whether the ministry is two or 200,000, the focus is, "What Has the Lord given me to do?" "Be faithful to His revealed vision and calling!

The **FCMI-200** theme for 2005 is **'He Gave Some... For The Equipping Of The Saints'**

October 15 till November 15

we will be in Mexico with a team for the **FCMI-Mexico Conference** and series of meetings. The team from Australia and USA will minister with those of Mexico to equip the saints to do the work of the ministry in the states of Mexico DF, Morelos and Puebla. Please pray for their churches to grow, saints to be fired up and vision increased for the growth of the millions of Mexico!

December 1-20 We have been invited to be in Malaysia for camps and prophetic teaching in the many churches there.

PRAYER POINTS

1. A team of the 5 fold ministries to be put into the field. In the USA, who will be able to go to the harvest around the world?

2. For our team to increase, to be able to go the places we are asked to go but cannot at this time. We need teachers, evangelists, prophets, and apostles to team up for the greater work.

4. Prayer for the blessing of the volunteers who have given hundreds of hours aiding the growth and maintenance of this ministry for nearly 20 years!

5. That God will activate 1000 to plant churches! To start families in the body of Christ! The harvest is white. Pray for the Lord of the Harvest to send Laborers into the Harvest.

6. For prayer warriors to pray for our ability to listen, hear and obey the voice of Christ!

We love you every one, are praying for you to fulfill your purpose in the Lord!
