From FCMI Mexico

One more experience in the Lord's service I

About 8 years ago, God allowed us to work with a missionary agency here in Cuernavaca, Mexico called WEC (World Evangelism for Christ).

They had bought a "mountain", a huge piece of land, where for the past 3-4 years they have been building a center to train Mexican and other Latin Christians, to become missionaries to the world, especially to the 10/40 Window (Muslim countries).

They have concluded the second year now of preparing these missionaries.

There it is hard for blond Americans to minister, and is easier for the darker, Latin looking people. They can blend in easier in those countries.

At the moment there is one Mexican couple, with their two daughters, serving in Morocco. WEC is a non-denominational group, where Spirit filled Christians work together with other denominations.

Another part of WEC is bringing short-term missionaries to spend

from 1 to 9 months here in Mexico. This helps them find out if their calling is really to be missionaries. These normally come from Europe or the United States. This is where we (my mother Frances and I) come in. These short-term missionaries, who are normally around 20 years old (Melanie was an exception, being almost 40), take 4 weeks of Spanish classes, to learn some basic Spanish for their time of serving God here. This has been a blessing for us, because we get not only to teach them the language, but we are the first contact they have here, together with their WEC supervisor who sees them once a week.

For many it is their first overseas experience, or their first time away from home. So we really see how being ONE in Christ makes us have a bonding that is special for that time of classes and shepherding.

For us it is a financial blessing also, because although we charge them a special low price, it is still 2 hours a day of classes, which does help us out. And we have seen God's hand in this, because when we need extra money for something, WEC calls asking if we can take a student.....So the amazing thing is the way God makes connections between HIS children all over the world, and how he finds ways to bless them.

For us it has been an inspiration, to observe the lives of some of

these WEC missionaries, who have sold their houses in their home country and have come to bless the Mexican people. It is marvellous seeing them willing to live a life full of sacrifices, away from their families and friends.

And as for us "Mexicans", I think it is time to give to other nations what we have freely received.

So please pray for this WEC project and that many will be reached for our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Harold has been in his element carrying the prophetic load!
